

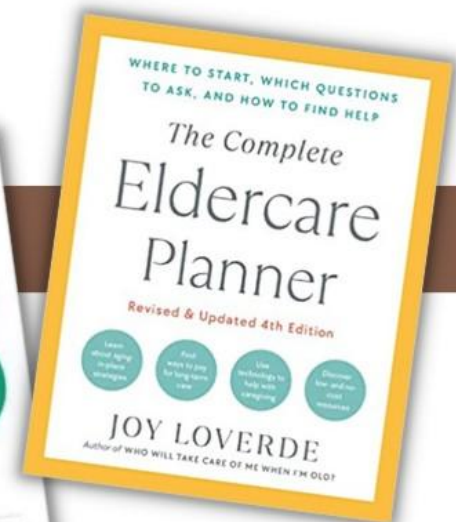
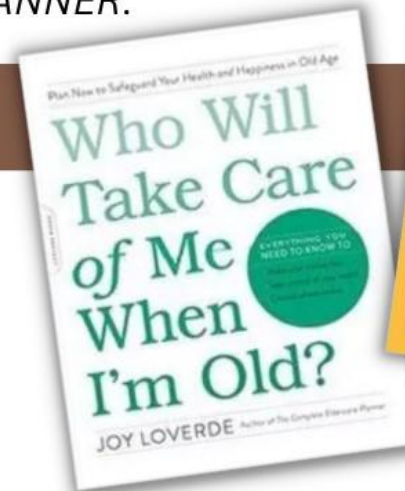

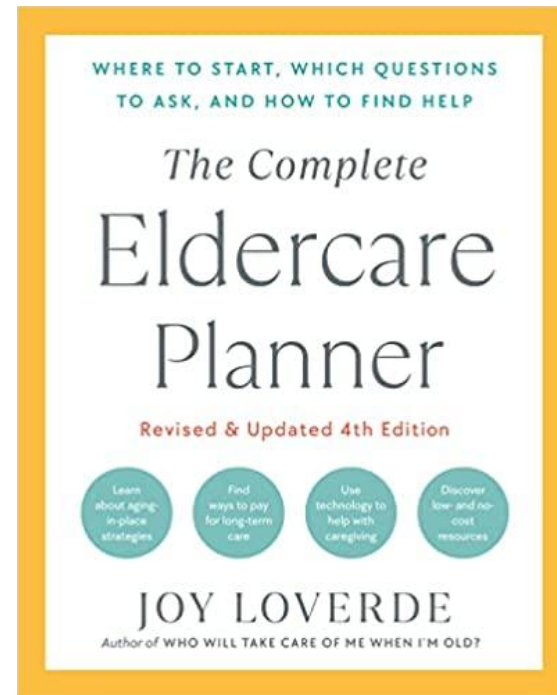
- Who might land on my doorstep seeking my attention and care?
