CAN YOU RELATE?



- You struggle with where to start
- You've started multiple times
- You're ready to downsize and photos are the biggest headache
- You feel like the photo gatekeeper instead of the family historian
- You need that space back in your closets!
- You feel as though your kids won't care about the photos.



THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN GETTING STARTED

- What do I want it to look like when I'm done? Begin with the end in mind.
- How do I want to use & share my collection?
- Will I be scanning and digitizing photos?
- Who else will I want to provide access to my photos?
- When do I want to complete this project?





Tools We Recommend

- Nitrile, Nylon or Cotton Gloves
- Photo safe pencil Stabilo
- 4 x 6 index cards
- 2 x 2 sticky notes
- Archival boxes or temporary shoe boxes
- Plastic Bins
- Mask
- Garbage Bin or Bag

A TOOL WE DIDN'T MENTION...







Get Grumpy Cat (or dog) off the Table

- Dedicated Space
- Dining Room Table
- Banquet Table
- Spare Room Bed
- Room with a door if you're lucky
 leave it out if that helps
 motivate you
- Have some plastic bins with lids ready to store your materials

Hunt and Gather

- Where are your photos hiding?
 - Closets, drawers, refrigerator doors, under the bed, attic, basement, garage
 - Are there photos in frames that you'd like to include?
 - Are there albums tucked in bins that need attention?
- If it's currently together, keep it together for now.
- This stage can be ugly...don't be discouraged

- VHS Tapes & other Video Tapes















Initial Organization

- Place like with like
- Keep photos that were grouped together, grouped together
- Keep negatives with their photos
- Loose photos can be grouped together in a batch for later sorting



REDUCING THE VOLUME

- Remove photos from albums if that makes sense for you
- Remove the garbage receipts, envelopes, unneeded paper, old boxes and containers that aren't photo safe
- Keep one copy of the school portraits
- Remove & toss the duplicate photos
- Purge the sunsets, landscapes and poor-quality photos.
 Be ruthless if you can
- Remove the almost duplicate photos if they don't serve a purpose
- Transfer any identifying information from photo envelopes
- Move photos and associated negatives to archival envelopes and toss the drug store envelopes





WHEN SHOULD I HIRE A PROFESSIONAL?

- When you lack time or desire to do this project yourself
- Hire for the things you'll only do one time
- Hire for the technical expertise and equipment
- When you're moving and you need to stage your home




What does the process look like to work with Photo Archivers
